Bylaw no. 361 concerning firearms and other arms within the Village of Senneville

It is decreed and ruled as follows:

ARTICLE I -

The use of all guns, carabines, pistols, and other firearms or bows, air guns are prohibited in the Village of Senneville.

ARTICLE II -

It is forbidden for all persons within the limits of the Village of Senneville and the first 500 meters of the shoreline within the territorial water limits of the Village of Senneville to use or discharge any gun, carabine, pistol and any other arms, also it includes air guns and bows.

Modified by bylaw 361-01, in force on March 24, 1999

ARTICLE III -

Anyone who contravenes the present by-law commits an infraction of this by-law and is liable for a fine of 100 dollars for the first offence, 300 dollars for a second offence, and for each subsequent offence an amount of 500 dollars, all costs are added to same.

ARTICLE IV -

Each contravention constitutes a distinct infraction each day that this contravention continues.

ARTICLE V -

By-laws number 144 and 144-01 are by the present cancelled.

ARTICLE VI -

The present by-law comes into force according to law.
